

SELECTMEN'S MINUTES
MONDAY, DECEMBER 21, 2009

The meeting was called to order at 3:30 PM and minutes from the previous board meeting were accepted.

Discussion followed on an application to construct a single family home on a parcel of land located on Mt. Archer Road. The selectmen decided to support a recommendation by a member of the Conservation and Inland Wetlands Commission to situate the house on the front of the lot and pipe/pump grey water to a septic system installed at the rear of the property. In order to minimize wetlands damage/encroachment, the town would grant an easement over abutting property it owns to allow the septic system to be installed without having to build a road through the regulated area to reach the back of the lot. The impact would thus be considerably reduced as just a trench for the piping system to the septic field would have to be dug through the wetlands.

The selectmen will inform the Zoning Enforcement Officer of their support for the proposal and ask that they be kept informed of additional details as the application process continues.

There being no further business to conduct, the meeting was adjourned at 4:00 PM.
