

SELECTMEN'S MINUTES
MONDAY, FEBRUARY 1, 2010

Discussion followed on possible methods to deal with the fire well on Barbara David's Brush Hill Road property now that a conservation easement has been placed on the pond which will be held by the Lyme Land Conservation Trust. R. Eno will pursue the matter with Land Trust president George Moore.

Selectman Lord next presented correspondence from the Eight Mile River Wild and Scenic Committee indicating it is beginning to step up its activities now that federal funding has been secured. It is the committee's hope that the board of selectmen will continue to support its initiatives.
