

SELECTMEN'S MINUTES  
MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 18, 2017

Present: Parker Lord, Steven Mattson, Mark Wayland  
Public: Ben Kegley, John Kiker and Theodore Wayland

The meeting was called to order at 3:30 P.M. and the minutes for the previous meeting were accepted.

Theodore Wayland, a life scout, proposed an Eagle Scout project to build and install U.S. flag repository boxes in town hall and elsewhere for residents to use in assuring the correct disposal for flags. These boxes will be approximately 12" x 16" x 30" and are tentatively scheduled for installation around the first of the year. The board unanimously approved the installation in town hall and commended the scout on his project.

The board discussed the need to repair the wall at Marvin Cemetery and received guidance from Mr. Kegley of the construction issues involved. Mr. Lord will proceed with determining the location of the graves along the road to determine the potential for adjusting the wall's location further back from the road. Mr. Mattson will contact DOT to ascertain their potential involvement and requirements before moving forward with plans for the wall's reconstruction.

The board approved two tax refunds which will be filed along with these minutes.

Mr. Mattson advised the board that he has signed an extension of the Johnston land purchase and sale agreement until 12/29/17. This was required as we wait for the decision of the state for grant participation for the purchase.

A resident has requested approval for the paving of his driveway from Joshuatown Rd. along the roadbed of what has been termed Sleu Rd. The town has historically maintained that the "road" has never been a town road and research will be needed to review the issue prior to giving an opinion to the landowner.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 4:40 P.M.
