MONDAY, JULY 2, 2018

The meeting was called to order at 3:30 P.M. and the minutes for the previous meeting were accepted.

The board approved a tax refund request in the amount of \$83.58.

Plans for facilitating the July 4th parade were reviewed and all is in order.

The board was appraised of the completion of the bid process for purchasing a portion of electric costs through a CCM small town cooperative. Rates have been secured for the next 4 years and will remain static.

Selectman Kiker has prepared communication materials to announce the temporary opening of the transfer station on Fridays and the availability of an attendant at the Hamburg recycling center on Sundays.

The Fire Company has completed the sale of the 1990 engine that has been replaced by our new engine acquisition. The Greasy Creek, KY Volunteer Fire Department is happy with their new addition to the fleet.

Selectman Lord will be arranging a survey of the town's septic lagoon property to ascertain the property boundaries and potential use.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 4:52 P.M.
