MONDAY, AUGUST 6, 2018

The meeting was called to order at 3:34 P.M. and the minutes for the previous meeting were accepted.

The board approved a tax refund in the amount of \$27.90.

Selectman Kiker reviewed the plan for improving the town's website and will be bringing forward 3 themes for review and decision by September 14th. The board expressed their appreciation for his efforts and their anticipation for viewing these themes.

Selectman Kiker also discussed the summer Selectmen's newsletter and the board made a series of comments that will be incorporated into his draft.

The board agreed to add an executive session to the agenda for September 4th to discuss the impact of the Supreme Court's ruling in favor of the town in the Brockway's Ferry litigation.

Selectman Mattson updated the board on the presence of the Auditor for the town's annual financial audit and the high humidity conditions in Town Hall along with the efforts of the HVAC company to rectify the problem.
