



SELECTMEN'S MINUTES
MONDAY, OCTOBER 1, 2018

Present: Parker Lord, John Kiker, Steven Mattson

The meeting was called to order at 3:31 P.M. and the minutes of the previous meeting were accepted.

In preparation for the possible repair of the wall at Marvin Cemetery, the board is exploring the potential for relocating the wall away from the road travel lane and further back into the cemetery proper. To consider this cost savings measure, we must determine if any remains are located in the area of relocation. A proposal to use ground penetrating radar to locate any remains has been received and the board agreed to move forward with this technique. Selectmen Kiker and Lord will work with the firm to schedule an inspection and determine the options available.

The board decided to hold a Town Meeting on October 16, 2018 to obtain the necessary approval for the First Selectmen to execute the remaining contracts with the state that will release the funds for the Johnston land purchase. This should conclude the review process and allow the town to move to closing on the property. Selectman Kiker will prepare the needed legal notices and resident mailer cards announcing the meeting time and date.

The selectmen discussed the process for replacing a town crew vacancy and have initiated the interviewing of candidates.

Selectman Kiker reviewed new website development status and updated the board on the steps remaining.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 4:28 P.M.
