



SELECTMEN'S MINUTES
MONDAY, NOVEMBER 19, 2018

The meeting was called to order at 3:32 P.M. and the minutes of the previous two meetings were accepted.

The board reviewed CT DOT's 2019 paving plans for the town. Route 82 from East Haddam to the junction at Hadlyme four corners and all of Route 156 from Route 82 to Halls Rd will be paved and centerline rumble strips will be installed on portions of these routes.

The board was updated on the MIRA plant troubles/closing for a temporary disruption in garbage disposal. It is anticipated that the plant will be back on-line after November 27th and that Lyme's disposal will not be affected as we are a member municipality and will therefore receive preferential treatment.

The board reappointed 3 members of the Conservation Commission Inland Wetlands Agency; Paul Armond, Patrick Crowley and Priscilla Hammond.

Selectman Kiker was advised of a small number of term expiration corrections needed on the new website and he reviewed the increased usage data since conversion. The board anticipates continued increased visits and use of the town's website as we move forward.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 4:28 P.M.
