



SELECTMEN'S MINUTES
MONDAY, NOVEMBER 5, 2018

Present: Parker Lord, John Kiker, Steven Mattson

The meeting was called to order at 3:35 P.M. and the minutes of the previous meeting were accepted.

The Board approved 3 tax refund requests in the amounts of \$295.28, \$79.09 and \$114.41.

The Board also approved the appointment of Timothy Hildner to the Affordable Housing Commission and accepted Mark Wayland's resignation from the same commission.

Selectman Mattson updated the board on the approval gained from Stone Ranch Military Reservation for the trapping on beavers along the lower Grassy Hill Rd frontage that has been flooding the roadway and creating both labor expenditures and costly road repairs. This trapping will occur throughout the winter trapping season and in future seasons until the problem is corrected.

The board discussed the on-going Marvin Cemetery wall research and agreed to have a survey of the property done including the location of the grave sites as discovered by ground penetrating radar. The board also agreed to solicit a proposal for the engineering plan development.

Continued discussion of the western terminus of Brockway Ferry Rd was held and the board updated on the letter sent by legal counsel to the three residents bounded. They are being advised of the upcoming marking/monumenting of the roadway boundaries as found by the Selectmen and affirmed by the Supreme Court. During this marking period, encroachments of the roadway will be noted and the responsible residents asked to remove those obstacles.

Selectman Kiker reviewed the new website deployment and updated the board on the next steps upcoming to broaden the content of the website. Comments thus far of the new format have been positive.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 4:35 P.M.
