



SELECTMEN'S MINUTES
TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 19, 2019

Present: Parker Lord, John Kiker, Steven Mattson

The meeting was called to order at 3:32 P.M. and the minutes of the previous meeting were accepted.

The selectmen adopted a combined list of fees for all departments in Lyme. This consolidated list was prepared in preparation for the codification of regulations and ordinances of the town in an effort to add efficiency in adjusting fees without the need to revise each ordinance separately at town meeting. This list will be revised and adopted annually each January.

The First Selectman explained the 10-year capital plan to the board to allow for their input prior to discussing the plan with the Board of Finance at their next meeting. The capital plan will provide a future look at the largest town expenditures and allow for those needs to be prioritized and sequenced to achieve the most manageable financial plans out into the future.

Selectman Kiker discussed his media campaign to explain what can and cannot be recycled at each of our facilities. In addition to educating the residents on the value of recycling, this effort is intended to reduce the level of garbage being dumped at the recycling center on Hamburg Rd when the items can be taken to the transfer station on Brush Hill Rd.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 4:17 P.M.
