Open Space Commission

Meeting Minutes

April 23, 2019

In attendance: Parker Lord, Ross Byrne, Bob Cope, Anthony Irving, George Lombardino and Lucius Stark

The meeting was called to order at 7:07pm. Business items included:

1. Johnston Preserve: To prepare the property for public access, Don Gerber marked the perimeter boundaries and Anthony continues flagging hiking trails. Additionally, the town engineer has received preliminary approval from Inland Wetlands for the driveway location. Working to State highway standards, he is now developing a blueprint for the driveway and parking area – in particular, ensuring sightlines at the entrance extend 500 feet in either direction.
2. Selden Landing: Parker, exploring new options for bridging an expanse of mudflats and wild rice at Selden Creek, contacted the manufacturer of an all-aluminum modular walkway that sits on footpads. The structure they proposed, however, far exceeded size regulations (and our price range). Ross, acting on a suggestion by Parker, volunteered to ask Keith Nielsen of Docko to attend a future OSC meeting and help devise a solution within regulatory and budgetary constraints.
3. Anthony made a motion, seconded by Ross and passed unanimously, to approve the minutes of the February meeting.
