



SELECTMEN'S MINUTES
MONDAY AUGUST 19, 2019

Present: Parker Lord, John Kiker, Steven Mattson

The meeting was called to order at 3:31 P.M. and the minutes of the previous meeting were accepted.

Selectman Kiker reported that all is ready for the 9/3/19 inclusion of GIS mapping on the town's website.

Selectman Kiker has also provided the recommendations of the board for repairs and the name of a local contractor that would be able to assist the Joshuatown Rd. owner for the water runoff conditions that exist.

The board appointed Melinda Kronfeld as Acting Assessor replacing her earlier appointment by the Assessor as the Assistant.

The board discussed a resident's concerns over the use of chemicals to control weed growth along the road's guard rails and catch basins. The potential harm and significant financial costs of manual control were discussed and weighed. The board decided to take no action on a change in method at this time.

The board reviewed the difficulty gaining approval from CTDOT for the entrance to the small parking area at the Johnston preserve and agreed to arrange a meeting with the engineer to review the town's options.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 4:03 P.M.
