



SELECTMEN'S MINUTES
MONDAY DECEMBER 16, 2019

Present: John Kiker, Steven Mattson

The meeting was called to order at 3:32 P.M. and the minutes of the previous meeting were accepted.

The board noted the absence of Mr. Lord and expressed their hope for his speedy return.

Three tax refunds were approved in the amounts of \$148.92, \$35.88 and \$257.42.

The board was advised that the long awaited CTDOT permit for the entrance to the Johnston Preserve was approved. An encroachment permit has been applied for to allow for work to be performed on Rte 82. When received, work will be planned for the creation of an entrance and a small parking area along with the installation of signage. The parking should be completed in the spring when the asphalt plant is again operating, and a dedication will then be scheduled.

The Eastern Regional Tourism District has requested a member from Lyme be appointed and Selectman Kiker will contact the District for more information while a representative is sought.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 4:06 P.M.
