



SELECTMEN'S MINUTES – VIRTUAL MEETING  
MONDAY MAY 18, 2020

Present: Parker Lord, John Kiker, Steven Mattson, Dan Hagan

The meeting was called to order at 3:33 P.M. and the minutes of the previous meeting were accepted.

The board reappointed Dennis Overfield to the Rogers Lake Authority.

The board was updated on the Board of Finance's recent adoption of the FY 2020/21 budget as proposed and their decision to set the Mill rate for the upcoming fiscal year at 19.95 Mills which represents no increase in property taxes for the third year of the past 4 years.

The board also reviewed the town facility reopening plan which will begin on May 20 with a phased reopening of all facilities. The board will monitor local infection rates very carefully as the facilities reopen and will be ready to react to any spike in infections that we hope will not occur.

Efforts on the town's two major bridge projects continue. Selectman Kiker has agreed to publish a notice of our impending DEEP application for Birch Mill Rd bridge. Once accomplished, our engineering firm will be able to apply for approval of the project as we await acceptance of our grant for 50% of the project's cost from the CT Local Bridge Program.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 4:03 P.M.
