



SELECTMEN'S MINUTES – VIRTUAL MEETING
MONDAY MAY 4, 2020

The meeting was called to order at 3:33 P.M. and the minutes of the previous meeting were accepted.

The board approved the reappointment of 3 members of the Open Space Commission: Humphrey Tyler, Anthony Irving and Robert Cope. The board also thanked Barbara David for her membership and service to the town as she has declined appointment to another term.

The board also approved reappointments of the 4 members of the Pension Advisor Committee: Dan Hagan, John Kiker, Steven Mattson and Milton Waters.

The board held a blind lottery drawing for available mooring permits in the waters of the town. 6 moorings were available, and 13 applications had been received. Maddy Mattson blindly drew 6 numbers from the hat to award these mooring permits. The numbers were drawn in the following order: 1, 5, 3, 7, 13 and 4. The town clerk will notify all applicants of the status of their applications.

The board approved a tax refund request in the amount of \$87.28.

A discussion followed on the necessary preparatory steps should the Governor's reopen the state; possibly as early as May 20. Plans for a staggered restart of town facilities are being developed with the necessary distancing requirements and employee protections. Final plans will be disclosed after receiving guidance from the Governor.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 3:55 P.M.
