



SELECTMEN'S MINUTES – VIRTUAL MEETING
MONDAY JUNE 1, 2020

The meeting was called to order at 3:35 P.M. and the minutes of the previous meeting were accepted.

The board appointed Rolf Wolfswinkle as a new at-large member of the Open Space Committee.

The Board discussed the community's July 4th parade and agreed that this event would violate the Governor's order limiting outdoor gatherings to 25 people. As such, the town will not be arranging a road closure permit or police protection and will publish notice on our website and social media that the event cannot be held this year.

The board reviewed the results of our reopening plan thus far. The transfer station and recycling center are again in operation with heavy volumes. The town hall and library staffs are back in the buildings and we anticipate public access on a limited basis beginning June 8th.

The board was made aware of an intended community mask give away being planned for June 9th for the residents of Lyme and Old Lyme sponsored by the Visiting Nurse and both towns. The details will be announced as soon as they become available.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 4:01 P.M.
