



SELECTMEN'S MINUTES
MONDAY AUGUST 3, 2020

Present: Parker Lord, John Kiker, Steven Mattson

The meeting was called to order at 3:30 P.M. and the minutes of the previous meeting were accepted.

The board discussed the delayed plan for the full reopening of town facilities now tentatively planned for September 8, 2020. This new timetable acknowledges the increase in Lyme positive COVID-19 test results that have raised the number of positive results in town from a single case to 6 cases. Future reopening dates will be dictated by these case number changes and until then, the town hall and library will remain open to the public on the current 3 day per week schedule.

A tax refund request in the amount of \$200.00 was approved.

The board reviewed the FY 2019/20 year-end financial results and the materials to be presented to the Board of Finance at the August 11, 2020 meeting. The town had another very good financial year and returned more that \$500,000 to the general fund beyond the budget expectations. These results were driven by tax collections of previous tax amounts in arrears and spending below the levels authorized.

The board also discussed concerns involving the Ely Ferry Landing and associated parking issues. The board will consider the creation of a limited number of parking spaces at the landing and placing no parking signs on areas other than the designated parking created.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 4:04 P.M.
