The Lyme Conservation Commission, acting as Inland Wetlands and Watercourses Agency, held a virtual regular meeting on August 19, 2020 at 7:00 p.m.

Dill called the meeting to order at 7:06 p.m.

Seat Alternate Member

Alternate member Christine Darnell was seated for absent regular member Beverly Crowther.

REGULAR MEETING

Novak, 138 Norwich Salem Rd, Tax Map 22 Lot 1; continued discussion on remediation of violation, cutting within the setback area.

Present: Brandon Novak

Novak provided the commission with a site plan, list of plantings, and sequencing information. Byrne stated that he went to the site with Novak and they took measurements together. The site plan is accurate.

Hessel asked for clarification on the size of the area where the spice bushes and winterberry would be planted and Novak stated each will fill an area of about 75 feet by 8-10 feet, with a total replanting area of about 25 feet by 150 feet.

Novak stated there has been no washout from the disturbed area into the pool or undisturbed portion of the property near the pool.

Byrne said the heavy woodchip cover was enough to prevent any erosion.

Darnell stated that she was happy with the plan and thinks the Rhus aromatica is a good choice and Hessel agreed.

Dill asked when the work will be completed and Novak stated the remediation would take place in about a month, with the exception of the lawn installation which may be pushed to the spring and the commission was agreeable to this timeframe.

Dill entertained a motion to accept the plan as presented. Reynolds made the motion, seconded by Hessel, and the motion passed unanimously.
