



SELECTMEN'S MINUTES
MONDAY FEBRUARY 1, 2021

Present: Parker Lord, John Kiker, Steven Mattson

The meeting was called to order at 3:32 P.M. and the minutes of the previous meeting were accepted.

The board reappointed Iain R. Horwath as an alternate member of the Hadlyme Ferry Historic District Commission. The commission will be looking to recommend 2 additional alternate members in the near future for appointment.

The board also appointed Regan Stacey as one of the 3 town representatives to the Eight Mile River Wild and Scenic Coordinating Committee.

The Operating Expense portion of the proposed budget for fiscal year 2021/22 was discussed and approved prior to the presentation to the Board of Finance at their next meeting on February 9, 2021. The draft proposal calls for a small decrease.

The board discussed a request from the Old Saybrook March for Justice organization regarding "advancing an antiracist agenda" in Lyme. The board agreed that such a resolution as requested, while supported by the board, rightfully should be addressed by the residents at a future town meeting and not by the Board of Selectman. Selectman Kiker will communicate with the organization regarding our position.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 4:05 P.M.
