



SELECTMEN'S MINUTES
TUESDAY FEBRUARY 16, 2021

The meeting was called to order at 3:32 P.M. and the minutes of the previous meeting were accepted.

The board discussed the pending March 1, 2021 retirement of the Town Historian, Carolyn Bacdayan. The Board expressed its thanks to Carolyn for her years of service to the town as Historian and Archivist of the Public Hall Archives. Her mastery of the town history was a welcome help to visitors and to the town through her contributions to the town's annual report.

A discussion of an offer to remove a small area of barberry from a Mt Archer woods site as mitigation of wetlands disturbance from a property owner was held. The board declined to accept the offer.

The board reviewed the Capital Expense portion of the 2021/22 budget that will be presented to the Board of Finance at their 2/23/21 meeting.

Six tax refund requests to a single individual were reviewed and approved in the total amount of \$1,384.17.

The board was advised of a resignation of Hunter Ward from the P&Z Commission after 24 years of service. The board thanks Hunter for his knowledge and commitment to this commission and the town.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 4:07 P.M.
