Seat Alternate Member

Alternate member Christine Darnell was seated for absent regular member Paul Armond.

REGULAR MEETING

Thomas and Andrea Wing, 60 Brush Hill Rd, Tax Map 12, Lot 64; application to remove invasive plant material within the regulated area and replant with native species.

Dill stated that all of the present commission members had visited the site and asked for any comments or questions.

The members each spoke in favor of the plan, agreeing that it was well thought out and will promote diversity of the site.

Dill pointed out that the applicant may want to consider removing a few more trees than those marked and the applicant thanked him for the suggestion.

Dill called for a motion.

Darnell made a motion to approve the application to remove invasive material within a regulated area and replant with native species and to thin out spruces and some mature trees under the guidance of an arborist. Hessel seconded the motion, and the application was unanimously approved.

Byrne brought to the attention of the commission that there has been unpermitted cutting in a regulated area on the property of Anna Salvatore and Ryan Brouwer, 3 Avenue B, Tax Map 40.2 Lot 3. A cease and desist letter has been sent to the owners by certified mail and a special meeting has been scheduled for Wednesday March 24, 2021 at 7:00 p.m. to address the issue.
