



SELECTMEN'S MINUTES
MONDAY AUGUST 2, 2021

Present: Parker Lord, John Kiker, Steven Mattson with David Lahm and Bob Cope

The meeting was called to order at 3:31 P.M. and the minutes of the previous meeting were accepted.

The board reviewed the financial report for the end of the 2020/21 fiscal year that will be presented to the BOF at their next meeting. The town enjoyed a \$800,000 positive result compared to the budget expectations.

The board appointed Alan Schneiness to the Pension Advisory Committee.

The board was also advised of the hiring of a new individual and his training as a future replacement of the town's Building Official along with additional responsibilities.

The annual audit of the town's finances will begin on Monday August 9, 2021.

The board also discussed the possibility of returning to mandated mask wearing within town facilities for both vaccinated and unvaccinated employees and visitors based upon the recent CDC recommendations. Regional infection data will be followed closely prior to adoption of these rules.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 4:06 P.M.
