



SELECTMEN'S MINUTES
MONDAY SEPTEMBER 20, 2021

The meeting was called to order at 3:31 P.M. and the minutes of the previous meeting were accepted.

The board approved 5 tax refund requests in the amounts of \$10.27, \$94.20, \$301.96, \$44.75, and \$71.66.

DOT has advised the town that the Rte. 82 detour over Salem Rd has been extended until October 1, 2021.

Lyme's Burning Official has retired effective 10/1/21 and Josh Adams has been appointed to assume this role. The board thanked Gary Weed for his many years of volunteer service to the town.

A project to rebuild the culvert on Grassy Hill Rd that was washed out in storm Ida will begin on Thursday 9/23/21. This repair will require that Grassy Hill Rd be closed to traffic for up to 2 weeks. The school bus company has been advised and the website will be updated to warn the residents.

The board was advised of resignations from 4 boards: Estuary Transit District, Hadlyme Ferry Historic District, Open Space Committee, and RiverCOG's Regional Planning Committee. Replacements will be sought.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 4:08 P.M.
