



SELECTMEN'S MINUTES
MONDAY OCTOBER 18, 2021

Present: Parker Lord, John Kiker, Steven Mattson with David Lahm

The meeting was called to order at 3:31 P.M. and the minutes of the previous meeting were accepted.

The board appointed Sue Cope, Sarah Crisp, and Diana Fiske to the Sustainable Committee and David Lahm as the town representative to the Estuary Transit District.

The board approved a tax refund request in the amount of \$19.15.

The first quarter financial results were reviewed prior to its presentation to the Board of Finance on October 19.

The board was advised that the steps have been completed for the town to set its own local road speed limits that were previously the domain of CT DOT. A process must be followed to advise the state of any changes made.

A discussion was held regarding subjects that have arisen that are managed by the town on a non-normal basis. These included the town's role of housing property when an eviction takes place and the future of garbage disposal after the Hartford burn plant closes on 7/1/22 and the need to transport waste to out of state landfills at significantly higher costs to the town.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 4:22 P.M.
