



SELECTMEN'S MINUTES  
MONDAY NOVEMBER 15, 2021

Present: Parker Lord, John Kiker, Steven Mattson with David Lahm, Bernie Gigliotti and Mary Powell-St Louis

The meeting was called to order at 3:33 P.M. and the minutes of the previous meeting were accepted.

The board recognized today as the last BOS meeting for Selectman Lord and thanked him for his 24 years of service to the board. The board also welcomed David Lahm who will begin his term as 3<sup>rd</sup> Selectman on 11/16/21 along with Selectmen Kiker and Mattson who will begin their 3<sup>rd</sup> terms as selectmen.

The board discussed and approved the BOS regular meeting schedule for 2022.

The board appointed Parker Lord as an at-large member of the Open Space Commission and John Kiker as Selectmen's Representative to that commission.

Board also appointed William Hawthorne as Treasurer through 6/30/22.

The board discussed the Library Board's intent to elect new leadership and the need to appoint 2 new members. The board decided to hold appointments until after leadership has been selected.

The board reviewed a request by a property owner to transfer ownership of the Thurston/Holbrook Cemetery to the town's ownership. The steps involved were discussed including the need for approval from the P&Z Commission and at Town Meeting. The board authorized the First Selectmen to execute the papers necessary to bring this transfer to completion.

A discussion was held regarding the remaining board vacancies and such appointments will be made at the next BOS meeting or when candidates can be located.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 4:24 P.M.
