



SELECTMEN'S MINUTES  
MONDAY JANUARY 18, 2022

Present: John Kiker, David Lahm, Steven Mattson with Mary Powell St Louis and Ernest Lammer

The meeting was called to order at 3:31 P.M. and the minutes of the previous meeting were accepted.

The board appointed Ann Littlefield to the Open Space Committee as the P&Z representative.

Selectman Kiker presented a change in the town's website hosting. Board approved the change to SiteGround as host and noted that no budget impact is associated with this change.

Board discussed the second distribution of COVID test kits and N95 masks. Approximately 300 cars were served and the supply of 160 test kits were depleted again. The town has not yet been notified of future kit supply and will schedule another distribution when supply again becomes available.

Selectman Lahm has agreed to lead an exploration of the volunteer pension plan following the Ambulance and Fire company's request to alter the plan within the limitations imposed by the IRS.

Mr. Lammer made the board aware of some medical issues which will require him to miss work for a number of days over the next 3 months and his need to access sick leave that has accrued. The board will plan coverage during his absences.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 3:53 P.M.
