MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF January 12, 2022

A meeting of the Rogers Lake Authority (RLA) was convened virtually at 7:30 PM on January 12, 2022. The meeting of the Rogers Lake Authority was called to order at 7:34 pm by Dennis Overfield.

The minutes from December were read aloud. A motion to accept the minutes from December was made by Toni, Jenell second, motion passed unanimously.

Old Business

The marker permit application was sent to DEEP. Mark updated the board on the Ranger Program information gathering and how having a constable issue tickets on the lake might work.

New Business

Discussion took place on how summer RLA employment might work this season. John is still interested in working this summer possibly in the supervisor position which would include recruitment of seasonal staff as needed. Jenell made a motion to extend the RLA patrol boat supervisor position to John Freer for the 2022 season, Maneesha second, motion passed by unanimous vote. The seasonal job descriptions were reviewed and updated. Toni made a motion to use Tom Mendelci's dock again this year for docking the boat, if he agrees, Jenell second, motion passed unanimously. DEEP has given permission for RLA to be at the boat launch for horsepower regulation only. Seasonal employees will need to be flexible with being assigned to positions as needed. The summer job posting will be placed on the town website and flyers will be made for advertising around town.

The board reviewed the CT Agricultural Experiment Station aquatic weed map which shows specific locations of invasive weeds. The board will put together a request for quote for weed treatment options. Three vendors will need to provide estimates for the weed treatment. Water quality testing options were discussed, a request for quote will need to be agreed on and created. Also, a request for quote needs to be drafted regarding the Asian Clams.

A motion to adjourn was made by Jenell, Maneesha second, motion passed by unanimous vote.
The meeting ended at 9:00 PM.
