



SELECTMEN'S MINUTES  
MONDAY FEBRUARY 7, 2022

Present: John Kiker and Steven Mattson with David Lahm by phone and Jeri Baker, Alan Sheiness and Mary Powell St Louis in attendance.

The meeting was called to order at 3:31 P.M. and the minutes of the previous meeting were accepted.

The board appointed Alan Sheiness to the Lyme's Senior Center Building Committee.

The board held a review discussion with Jeri Baker, Chair of the Senior Center Building Committee, regarding the center's expansion plan and the future budget needs of the committee. Jeri reviewed the senior center's growth and limitations to providing programs stemming from the facilities size and configuration. The committee's architect has completed a feasibility study providing potential building changes and options. The next phase of the committee's work will be to develop the plans and drawings necessary to have construction bidding take place. The board ask Jeri to answer a series of questions that will enable the BOS to plan for the investment required along with the timing of those investments. The BOS expressed its support for an expansion of the facility.

The board also reviewed the materials regarding the next fiscal year budget that will be provided and discussed with the Board of Finance over the next two weeks.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 5:13 P.M.
