

Town of Lyme, Connecticut Resolution
Supporting IDA-Compliant Lighting at
Municipal Facilities

WHEREAS, the Town of Lyme, Connecticut has previously passed a Resolution on December 21, 2020 supporting participation in the Sustainable CT Municipal Certification Program.


WHEREAS, the Town of Lyme adopted such Resolution in order to embrace an ongoing process of working toward greater sustainability, selecting which actions it chooses to pursue from the voluntary menu of actions provided by Sustainable CT.

WHEREAS, Sustainable CT advocates for municipal policies to analyze lighting needs at municipal facilities, reduce unnecessary lighting, and to replace and install municipal outdoor lighting with products that have the IDA Fixture Seal of Approval (or equivalent), including shielded lighting (where permitted), motion sensor activated lighting, and downward- rather than upward-directing lighting.

RESOLVED, by the Board of Selectmen of the Town of Lyme that with respect to all municipal facilities we do hereby advocate for the reduction of unnecessary lighting.

RESOLVED, by the Board of Selectmen of the Town of Lyme, to allow for an evaluation of lighting at municipal facilities.

RESOLVED, by the Board of Selectmen of the Town of Lyme to include in future budget proposals, consistent with the findings of



lighting evaluations and subject to fiscal constraints at the time, replacement of non-IDA-compliant municipal outdoor lighting with products that have the IDA Fixture Seal of Approval (or equivalent), including shielded lighting (where permitted), motion sensor activated lighting, and downward- rather than upward-directing lighting.
