



SELECTMEN'S MINUTES
MONDAY JUNE 6, 2022

Present: John Kiker, David Lahm, and Steven Mattson with Mary Powell-St Louis

The meeting was called to order at 3:33 P.M. and the minutes of the previous meeting were accepted.

The board reappointed Rolf Wolfswinkel, Robert Cope, Anne Littlefield, and Anthony Irving to the Open Space Committee. Board also reappointed William Hawthorne as Treasurer.

The Selectmen discussed the town's July 4th parade. State road closure permit has been received and the Fire Company has agreed to provide manpower for road detours as well as participating in the parade. Board voted to designate Parker Lord as the parade's Grand Marshall in recognition of his long and outstanding service to the town.

The board recognized the work of the Sustainable Committee in receiving the Bronze level award from the Sustainable CT program after an intense period of work. It also recognized the Affordable Housing Commission in completing the affordable housing plan for the town.

The next meeting of the Board of Selectmen will be held on Tuesday June 21, 2022, at 3:30pm.

The Selectmen were asked to operate the recycling center on Saturday June 18th to cover for the absence of the usual operator.

Selectman Mattson advised the board that he will be retiring as First Selectman at the July 5th BOS meeting and thanked the town for the privilege of serving. At the 7/5 meeting, following Selectman Mattson's resignation, the remaining board members will vote to appoint a new First Selectman and to appoint a new member to the board.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 4:05 P.M.
