



SELECTMEN'S MINUTES  
TUESDAY JULY 5, 2022

Present: John Kiker, David Lahm, Steven Mattson and Kristina White with approximately 20 members of the public in attendance

The meeting was called to order at 3:30 P.M. and the minutes of the previous meeting were accepted.

The board approved the following appointments:

Affordable Housing Commission – David M. Lahm.

Pension Advisory Committee – David M. Lahm and John Kiker.

Fire Company Incentive Program Trustee – David M. Lahm and John Kiker.

The board approved 10 requests for tax refunds in the amount of \$1,319.77

First Selectman Steven Matson submitted his written resignation which was effective immediately. Mr. Matson said a few words and received a standing ovation from the Board and members of the public.

The meeting was then turned over to Second Selectman John Kiker. Mr. Kiker made some well-deserved congratulatory comments regarding Mr. Matson's tenure as First Selectman. At that time Mr. Kiker addressed the vacancy left by Mr. Matson's resignation. Mr. Kiker nominated Third Selectman David M. Lahm to fill the remainder of Mr. Matson's term. The motion was seconded and approved by unanimous vote. First Selectman Lahm was then sworn in by Town Clerk Linda Winzer. At that time the meeting was turned over to Mr. Lahm.

Mr. Lahm then addressed the vacancy left by his elevation to First Selectman. Mr. Lahm nominated Kristina White to fill the remainder of the Third Selectman's term. The nomination was seconded by Mr. Kiker and approved by unanimous vote. Third Selectwomen Kristina White then was sworn in by Ms. Winzer and assumed her position on the Board.

The Board lauded Mr. Matson's accomplishments as First Selectman and thanked him for his two decades of service to the Town.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 3:45 P.M.
