



SELECTMEN'S MINUTES
Monday October 17, 2022

Present: John Kiker, David Lahm, and Kristina White.

The meeting was called to order at 3:31 P.M. and the minutes of the previous meeting were accepted.

The Board approved one tax refund request.

The Board voted unanimously to make the following appointments:

Treasurer, Town of Lyme – Peter Evankow

Affordable Housing Commission – Allyson Cotton

Eight Mile River Wild & Scenic Coordinating Committee – Christine Darnell

The Board of Selectmen approved the Town of Old Lyme's request to hire a new Assistant to the Director of the Senior Center. The new position will be 25 hours a week and have an additional cost to Lyme of approximately \$2,600 per year. The discussion of the new position considered that the current staffing model was put in place when the Senior Center membership was at 300 – 500. The current membership is 1,200.

Old Business – Selectwomen White will be exploring recycling models used in nearby towns, specifically Stonington's new proposal for recycling and municipal solid waste.

The Board also voted to change "or" to "and" on page 19, under the heading **DISCIPLINE FOR VIOLATIONS**, paragraph (5). This change allows Lyme town employees to hunt on Lyme town land that has been designated for hunting.

New Business – After a discussion concerning the Library Board, Selectmen Kiker and Lahm will attend Library Board meetings.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 4:12 P.M.
