



SELECTMEN'S MINUTES
Tuesday, January 17, 2023

Present: John Kiker, David Lahm, and Kristina White.

The meeting was called to order at 4:00 P.M. and the minutes of the previous meeting were accepted.

There were no tax refund requests.

The Board discussed a COVID – 19 test kit distribution at the Hamburg Fire Station in the near future. Once a date is set there will be notice on the Town website and the movable sign at the Fire Station.

Selectman Kiker and Selectwoman White will contact several individuals to possibly serve on the Gateway Commission.

The Board voted to approve the creation of a STIF account for the Affordable Housing fund which has a current rate of return of 4.5% versus the .25% it is currently earning.

The Board approved Selectman Lahm's recommendation that the Town follow the recommendation of Ledge Light Health District regarding requiring the wearing masks in Town buildings.

Old Business: Selectwoman White reported that Safe Futures training for EMS personnel will take place on February 28th.

New Business: The Board requested that Selectman Kiker draft a request for donations for energy subsidies for the Town's Social Services Bureau to be placed on the Town website.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 4:32 P.M.
