Monday, February 6, 2023

Present: John Kiker, David Lahm, and Kristina White.

The meeting was called to order at 4:00 P.M. and the minutes of the previous meeting were accepted.

There were two tax refund requests approved.

The Board discussed the results of the COVID – 19 test kit distribution at the Hamburg Fire Station. Six cars went through the line and were offered at least four kits. The Town still has many test kits available.

The Board discussed the draft FY 23/24 budget that Selectman Lahm will present to the Board of Finance on February 7<sup>th</sup>. Selectman Lahm answered several questions.

The Board discussed the Lyme 4<sup>th</sup> of July parade. Selectman Kiker will coordinate parade transportation. The Board also voted on a Parade Grand Marshal to be announced at a later date.

Old Business: The Board discussed the make up of the Conservation Commission and some possible changes.

New Business: the Board received a letter from Steve Olstein, Chief of Services for the Lyme Ambulance Association, requesting a meeting with the Board. The Board agreed to that meeting and Selectman Lahm will coordinate.
