



SELECTMEN'S MINUTES  
Monday, March 6, 2023

Present: John Kiker, David Lahm, and Kristina White.

The meeting was called to order at 4:00 P.M. and the minutes of the previous meeting were accepted.

There were no tax refund requests.

The Board discussed proposed changes to the election laws in order to implement the Constitutional Amendment authorizing early voting in Connecticut. Judy Davies, Republican Registrar for Lyme, was present and invited to discuss the different scenarios for early voting and what additional resources would be required to support each scenario. The board agreed to monitor the legislative progress and have Ms. Davies report back on additional resource estimates.

The Board discussed the progress made on the draft FY 23/24 budget that Selectman Lahm will present to the Board of Finance on March 21st. At this point a member of the public was present and inquired if money was being budgeted for improvements to Mitchell Hill Road. Selectman Lahm answered in the affirmative.

The Board discussed a request for funding support of the Lyme Creative Arts Program put on in the summer in conjunction with LYSB. The request was for \$2,550 over two years and was approved by the Board.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 4:35 P.M.
