



SELECTMEN'S MINUTES
Monday, May 1, 2023

Present: John Kiker, David Lahm, and Kristina White.

The meeting was called to order at 4:00 P.M. and the minutes of the previous meeting were accepted.

There were no tax refund requests.

Representatives from the Witness Stone Project made a presentation to the Board regarding the placement of stones to mark the presence of enslaved people in Lyme. Liz Frankel stated that she had identified 18 individuals who were enslaved in Lyme. The Board agreed, in concept, to allow the Witness Stone Project to place stones in the vicinity of the library. The exact location to be determined at a later date after consultations with the Library Director and the Garden Club.

The Board announced the date of the Town Meeting set for May 25th at 6:00pm at the Town Hall.

Old Business – Plans for the Lyme 4th of July Parade were discussed regarding the Grand Marshal's vehicle.

Selectwoman White updated the Board on her investigation into the feasibility of textile recycling.

New Business – Selectman Lahm informed the Board that the ARPA report had been filed by the April 30th deadline. The Board discussed the possibility of holding Town Concerts at the Hamburg Fair Grounds. Selectwoman White will contact and coordinate with the appropriate organizations.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 4:26 P.M.
