



SELECTPEOPLES'S MINUTES  
Monday, August 7, 2023

Present: John Kiker, David Lahm, and Kristina White.

The meeting was called to order at 4:00 P.M. and the minutes of the previous meeting were accepted.

There were no tax refund requests.

The following individual was appointed to Boards or Commissions.

- Library Board of Directors – Ralph Lewis

The Board unanimously voted, from this time forward, to refer to its self as the “Board of Selectpeople” and individuals to continue with either Selectman or Selectwoman.

First Selectman Lahm provided updates in the following areas:

- Bridges – Both the Birch Mill Road bridge and the Macintosh Road bridge are progressing well. The contractual completion dates are October 29<sup>th</sup> for the Macintosh bridge and December 29<sup>th</sup> for the Birch Mill bridge. The Birch Mill bridge project will be completed without any adverse effects on the local beaver population.
- The fiscal year close out was presented to the Board of Finance and the Selectman’s list of encumbrances was approved.

Old Business – Selectwomen White updated the Board on the final coordination for the placement of a textile recycling bin at the Hamburg recycling center in the near future.

New Business :

The town is submitting for a Small Town Economic Assistance grant in the amount of \$500,000 to help defray the cost of the Senior Center expansion project that was approved in this year’s budget. The Board voted to approve a resolution authorizing First Selectman Lahm to pursue the afore mentioned grant.

As part of an ongoing Army Corps of Engineers project to control the invasive species Hydrilla, Rhodamine WT tracer dye will be released in Selden Cove on August 29<sup>th</sup>.  
There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 4:23 P.M.
