



SELECTPEOPLES'S MINUTES  
Monday, August 21, 2023

Present: John Kiker, David Lahm, and Kristina White.

The meeting was called to order at 4:00 P.M. and the minutes of the previous meeting were accepted.

There were no tax refund requests.

First Selectman Lahm provided updates in the following areas:

- Bridges – The Macintosh Road Bridge remains ahead of schedule. The main support beams have been installed. Birch Mill Road Bridge is progressing well, and the demolition has been completed and the cofferdam has been installed. Concrete will start being poured this week.
- Open Positions – The Finance Director position has been filled by Morgan Regan. Lyme has one position open, Saturday recycling attendant at the Hamburg Public Safety Complex. We are actively seeking applicants.

Update on Fabric Recycling – The bin is in place and already appears to be well used. The Board of Selectpeople requests that residents strictly follow the instructions marked on the side of the bin.

Old Business – The Town has submitted for a Small Town Economic Assistance grant to help defer the cost to the Town for the Senior Center expansion project.

New Business :

The Board of Selectpeople will investigate the feasibility of providing a section of the Transfer Station to allow residents to drop off unwanted items that may be of use to others at no charge.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 4:35 P.M.
