



SELECTPEOPLES'S MINUTES  
Monday, October 16, 2023

Present: John Kiker, Christina White, and David Lahm.

The meeting was called to order at 4:00 P.M. and the minutes of the previous meeting were accepted.

Four tax refund requests were approved.

First Selectman Lahm provided updates in the following areas:

- Bridges – The Macintosh Road Bridge remains ahead of schedule with final paving being done on October 19th. The expected completion date remains October 29<sup>th</sup>. Birch Mill Road Bridge is progressing well. Substantial completion is scheduled for October 28<sup>th</sup>. The contractor has briefed that he has all the remaining work scheduled to meet the substantial completion date. Selectman Lahm stated that the substantial completion date may slip by several days.
- Mitchell Hill Road Repair – The repair project has been postponed to the Spring of “24” and completed within the fiscal year.

The Board of Selectpeople discussed open board or commission seats that currently open; the Board tabled appointments until after the November 7<sup>th</sup> election.

Selectman Lahm proposed that questions concerning recycling costs and additional athletic fields for the town be placed of the Plan of Conservation and Development.

Old Business: Beavers are still causing a risk to the Lyme road network and Selectman Lahm will retain a beaver control contractor.

New Business: The Board of Selectpeople received invitations to the annual Veterans of Foreign Wars dinner dance on October 28<sup>th</sup>. The Board will hold an executive session at its November 6<sup>th</sup> meeting to discuss upcoming personnel issues.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 4:38 P.M.
