The meeting was called to order at 4:00 P.M. and the minutes of the previous meeting were accepted.

One tax refund request, for an overpayment, was approved.

Selectman Lahm briefed the Board on the close out of the current fiscal year. At this time no departments are over budget. Fiscal year 23/24 books remain open until July 31st to account for late billings.

The Mitchell Hill Road repair project is going well and should be completed by July 8th and not the 1st as previously reported.

Sustainability Initiative: Selectman Lahm briefed the Board on sales of food recycling buckets. As of this date 25 buckets have been sold. Buckets may be purchased from Selectman Lahm at the Town Hall for \$25 cash or check. Selectwoman White is in the preliminary stages of applying for a USDA grant for food composting.

New Business – The Army Corps of Engineers will be applying herbicides to combat Hydrilla in Selden Cove August 5th – 9th.
