4:00 PM LYME TOWN HALL

Present: Christy Zelek, John Kiker, Tom St. Louis, with 1 member of the public present.

C. Zelek called the meeting to order at 4:02 pm.

T. St. Louis made a motion to accept the minutes from the July 6th meeting. J. Kiker seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

Public Comment: R. Keel spoke about the Grassy Hill Church bell ringing. The bell in Town Hall is in working order.

Appointments: Anthony Irving, as a Regular Member, and Regan Stacy, as an Alternate Member, to the Eight Mile River Wild and Scenic Coordinating Committee.

Other Business: Looking for a River Valley Transit representative and a Connecticut River Gateway alternate.

The River Cog Regional Housing is reviewing their report with Lyme this week.

The state is conducting Hydrilla research in Hamburg Cove beginning August 10 and running through November. There will be 4 ft yellow rings collecting data.

Proposed draft agreement providing mutual aid with Old Lyme with a primary focus on school safety, major incidents at public events such as Hamburg Fair, or potential evacuation.
